## **OBSERVATION SCHEDULE**

### **March 5, 2024 Presidential Primary Election**

The public is invited to observe as the Alpine County Registrar of Voters conducts a series of public events related to the election. All events will take place at the Alpine County Registrar of Voters office, 99 Water St, Markleeville according to the following schedule:

<i><b>February 9, 2024</b> – Logic and accuracy testing of the County’s high-speed ballot scanners, precinct ballot scanners and vote tabulation system begins at 2 pm</i>
<i><b>February 16, 2024</b> – Logic and accuracy testing of the County’s high-speed ballot scanners, precinct ballot scanners and vote tabulation system begins at 2 pm</i>
<i><b>March 5, 2024</b> - Ballots picked up 5 pm from United States Postal Service. Polls close at 8 pm and the release of voted ballots will begin shortly thereafter.</i>
<i><b>March 13, 2024</b>– E + 7 and the random precinct selection for the one percent manual tally of polling place ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners and precinct ballot scanners takes place at 9:30 am</i>
<i><b>March 13, 2024</b> – Logic and accuracy testing of the County’s high-speed ballot scanners, precinct ballot scanners and vote tabulation system begins at 9 am</i>
